Church Support

The council has approved the Outreach Leadership Team's recommendation to apply for a Ministry Initiative Fund Grant from Classis Zeeland to support a Hispanic Church plant at Bravo CRC called "My Father's House". Oakland is joining efforts with The River in Allegan to come up with a total of \$10,000 in mission support. The MIF grant will cover \$5,000, Oakland CRC will cover \$4,500 (from our mission fund), and The River will cover \$500. The grant is subject to classis approval.
