Lawn Care 2020/2021

Job Description

Responsible for the cultivation, care and appearance of the grounds around the Parsonage, Church and the Branch.

Primary Responsibilities

- Perform grounds keeping
- Mow Lawn (later in the week, i.e. sometime Thursday through Saturday)
- Trim and edge around the walks, landscape, walls and parking lot
- Keep landscape clear of weeds and debris
- Clear walkways and entrances of debris
- Keep Building and Grounds Liaison informed of maintenance needed for any equipment
- Inform Building and Grounds Liaison of issues with sprinkling system and pests
- Bids to be received on a yearly basis

Branch Custodian 2020/2021

Job Description

This position is 7 days a week

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Windows / Doors
 - Keep class clean on main entry doors
 - Interior window cleaning – monthly
 - Exterior window cleaning – yearly
 - Check West facing windows more often, may require further cleaning
- Bathrooms
 - Clean bathrooms weekly during the school year; as needed during summer break
 - Keep supplies on hand and stocked, replenish as necessary
 - This includes paper towel, soap levels, toilet paper, garbage bags, etc.
- Kitchenette
 - Clean appearance
 - Keep supplies on hand and stocked, replenish as necessary
 - This includes coffee, sugar, creamer, salt, pepper, paper goods, plastic ware, etc.
- Furnace
 - Change filter twice per year
- Cadet Room
 - Clean per request of Head Cadet Counselor, averaging one cleaning per month
- Offices
 - Clean as needed

General Tasks

- Coordinate with the Church secretary for off-scheduled events (i.e. baptisms, small gatherings, etc.)
- Keep supplies on hand and stocked, replenish as necessary
- May grant permission for items to be used outside of the Building. Borrowing anything from the church kitchen is permitted, but only with approval from the head custodian.
- Provide salt and scooper to be applied by the Pastor, Church Secretary and “The Branch” janitor.
- Change light bulbs when burned out.
- Keep entire building clean and neat.
